NO KINDERGARTEN ON THURSDAY, MARCH 29TH - THIS WILL BE KINDERGARTEN ROUNDUP!!

2018-2019 EAST BUTLER PRE-SCHOOL - Applications for 2018-2019 pre-school that will begin on August 14th in Brainard will be available on **February 16th**. Please stop by the Brainard office for an application. **Preschool applications will be accepted for in-district families February 26-March 2nd. We will begin accepting applications from out-of-district families March 5th-9th. Application must be complete with certified birth certificate and immunization records or application will not be accepted.** Preschool spots will be filled according to these applications. We will still accept applications after this window, but they will be on the waitlist if all spots have been filled. Students who are already in the program and are age eligible will retain a spot for the following year. Applicants will fill open spots based on age, oldest children (age 4) being accepted first and then the younger ones (age 3) if there is room. We will not be asking parents for their preference of morning/afternoon preschool. Open House information will be sent out at a later date. Children who are enrolled for preschool will be eligible to attend. Children age 3 or 4 on or before July 31st are eligible for pre-school. If your child will be 5 before July 31st please see the Kindergarten registration requirements. Pre-school will be Monday-Thursday. There will be a morning and afternoon session: Morning Session: 8:00 A.M.- 11:30 A.M. (Students can ride the morning bus route to school/will need to be picked up by parent); Afternoon Session: 12:00 P.M. – 3:30 P.M. (Students will need to be dropped off by parent/can ride afternoon bus route home). Pre-school Fee: \$60 per month/district students and \$70 per month/students out of the district, due on the first day of each month (this cost will include a snack each day and other incidentals that may occur). ATTENTION PARENTS: EAST BUTLER PUBLIC SCHOOLS ANNOUNCES REGISTRATION FOR 2018-2019 KINDERGARTEN - East Butler Public Schools will hold its kindergarten registration on March 26, 27, & 28, for students who will be entering kindergarten in August for the 2018-2019 school year. Any child who will reach the age of five on or before July 31, 2018 is eligible to enter kindergarten. Registration will be accepted at the Brainard school office from 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. on March 26, 27, & 28. A student's **certified birth certificate** and **immunization record** are required. Immunization requirements are: 3 doses of DTaP, DTP, DT, or Td vaccine, one given on or after the 4th birthday; 3 doses of Polio vaccine; 2 doses of MMR or MMRV vaccine, given on or after 12 months of age and separated by at least one month; 3 doses of pediatric Hepatitis B vaccine; and 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) or MMRV given on or after 12 months of age or written documentation (including year) of varicella disease from parent, guardian, or health care provider will be accepted. If the child has had varicella disease, they do not need any varicella shots. Also, students entering school for the first time, including kindergarteners, will be required to provide proof of a vision evaluation taken within six months prior to the student's entrance. Kindergarten physical examinations may be made within six months of the time of entry into kindergarten. Appointments can be made with your child's physician after March 1, 2018. Physical examination forms are available in the Brainard nurse's office. All families with children who are 5 years of age prior to July 31, 2018 are invited to attend Kindergarten Roundup at East Butler Public School in Brainard from 9:30-11:00 A.M. in the classroom on March 29th (9:30-10:30 A.M. STUDENTS ONLY/10:30-11:00 A.M. PARENTS MEETING). Kindergarten Roundup at East Butler Public School in Dwight from 9:30-11:00 A.M. in the classroom on March 29th (9:30-10:00 A.M. PARENT MEETING/10:00-11:00 A.M. STUDENTS ONLY).

Inclement Weather: The State Wrestling Championship will be held as scheduled unless severe weather conditions force the NSAA to make schedule and/or tournament format changes.

School Banners/Signs: NO school banner or sign can be put up in the CenturyLink Arena during the State Wrestling Championship! All banners and signs will be taken by CenturyLink staff if brought into the Arena and will be taken down if put up during the State Championship.

Spectator Tickets/Parking: Tickets are available at all Ticketmaster retail ticket center locations, Ticketmaster charge-by-phone in Omaha at (402)-422-1212 and Lincoln (402)-475-1212, online at Ticketmaster.com or at CenturyLink-Omaha Box Office. Tickets will be on sale during the State Championship at the CenturyLink-Omaha Box Office.

Saturday Tickets/Seating for FINALS--\$9.00 each-Student or Adult: The CenturyLink will sell on SATURDAY MORNING OF THE NSAA STATE WRESTLING CHAMPIONSHIPS an exclusive floor-level ticket that will allow seating on the north and south ends near the floor. There will be 300 seats suitable for viewing classes A and D (north end) and an additional 300 seats suitable for viewing classes B and C (south end) near the mats during the state finals portion only of Saturday's competition (when the configuration has been made to four mats). These tickets will **ONLY** be available starting at 7:30 a.m. Saturday, February 17th, 2018, at the ticket window at the CenturyLink-Omaha. **They will not be available through Ticketmaster® or the NSAA and they will not be sold prior to that time.** There is a strict limit of five tickets per purchase per person. No refunds or exchanges for other Saturday Finals tickets will be made by CenturyLink or the NSAA in lieu of these exclusive tickets.

Fan Parking: \$8.00-daily-one time; \$12.00 daily-in and out; \$12.00 garage. (Those using Lot A handicapped parking will need to have a pre-purchased ticket.)

Championship Results & Viewing: All of the State Championship results will be posted on the NSAA Homepage on the Wrestling section as soon as they become available during the Championship and also on the Trackwrestling.com website under 2018 NSAA Championships.

Live Viewing: All matches will be streamed LIVE on the Trackwrestling.com website and also on the <http://www.nfhsnetwork.com/associations/nsaa> link at nsaahome.org. Viewing requires a one-time fee for either website.

Archive Viewing and Downloading: To view a finished match, go to the 2018 NSAA Championships on Trackwrestling and select any match from the posted brackets and the green arrow will direct you to the subscription page. A one-time subscription will allow you to view any match that is archived in the Championship. With each subscription you will be allowed to download ten matches in HD. If you wish to download more than ten, a new subscription is required.

All Final Matches: All Final matches on Saturday, will be broadcast by Nebraska Educational Television (NET).

Student Media: School photographers and other School Media Personnel will not be permitted access to the main arena floor.

NSAA Championship Photos: Championship photos are available through Callam Sports Photography online at callamsportsphoto.com.

NSAA Championship DVDs: Championship DVDs of the finals matches are available through NET, www.netnebraska.org or toll-free 1-800-868-1868.

Clearing the facility: At the conclusion of the team awards at the end of the Championship Finals on Saturday – February 17th, the arena floor and the whole CenturyLink facility will need to be cleared as soon as possible.

Reminder: arena clear bag policy effective at NSAA State Wrestling

Later this month CenturyLink Center Omaha will once again host some of the best athletes in the state for the NSAA State Wrestling Tournament. This year, however, before entering the arena, spectators are asked to take note of the clear bag policy recently implemented by the Metropolitan Entertainment & Convention Authority (MECA).

The policy states the following items are permitted inside the CenturyLink Center Omaha arena:

- Clear plastic bags, measuring 12 inches tall, 12 inches long, and 6 inches wide
- Small or clutch-sized purses or wallets, not exceeding 4.5 inches tall by 6.5 inches long
- One-gallon, clear plastic freezer bags are permitted
- One bag is permitted per person

No large or oversized purses, backpacks or fanny-packs will be allowed past security. Just as in previous years, MECA will not permit professional cameras (with interchangeable lenses) inside the arena. However 'point and shoot' type cameras or video cameras continue to be admissible. Anyone who enters the building with unapproved items will be asked to dispose of them at their own discretion, or return the items to a vehicle. MECA employees are not allowed to hold or check bags during an event.

However, MECA understands the importance of recognizing our guests' medical needs. For that reason, after a brief search upon entry, bags of medical necessity will be tagged and admitted into the facility. Individuals carrying medical bags are simply asked to identify the bag to security checkpoint personnel, who will be happy to assist.

When your team has a break in their scheduled events, you are encouraged to explore all the features we have in place for more STEM exploration:

CEENBoT Robotics Games Booths in Hangar A features hands on robotics games that anyone can play to win buttons for participation. Participants and guests alike are encouraged to join in!

STEM and Robotics Exhibitors set up along the Mezzanine of Hangar A provide both informational booths and hands-on exploration of robotics and STEM applications from medical robots to mechatronics presented by professional STEM societies, non-profit, and educational organizations showcasing the many opportunities in STEM.

Creative and Visual Art Expo – 6th Annual Event - features robotic-inspired works of art created by local students and art teachers! 
Museum Rules:





