- Young people who use e-cigarettes may be more likely to smoke cigarettes in the future.

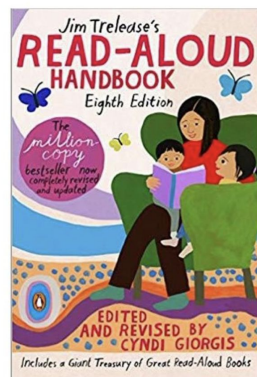
