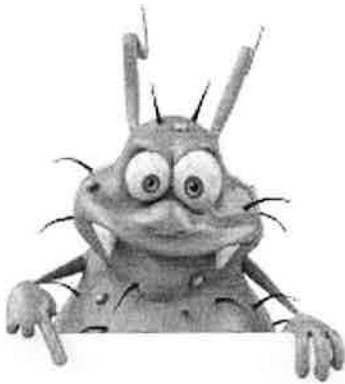

NOTES FROM THE NURSE...

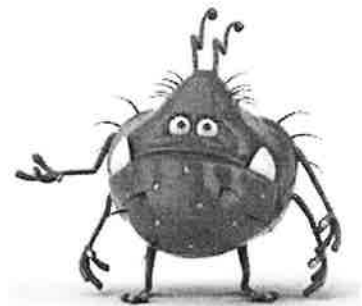
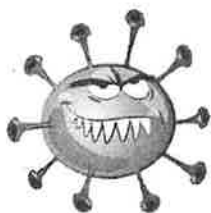


As the holiday season approaches so does the concern of flu, COVID and other respiratory illnesses. We have had an increase of respiratory illnesses, stomach flu and strep throat. It is important to follow the illness policy. Your child needs to be fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication and no episodes of vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours before returning to school.

As people will be gathering indoors in larger crowds the following are a few tips to keep you healthy:

- Cover your cough and sneezes
- Stay home – if you have the following symptoms: temp of 100 degrees or above, vomiting or diarrhea, severe cough, sore throat or other signs of acute illness.
