Please call the school office (402)545-2081 by Friday, March 5, 2021 for a registration packet to be mailed to you. Please bring your incoming Kindergarten student along with your child's certified birth certificate, immunization record, and completed registration packet.

Any child who will reach the age of five on or before July 31, 2021 is eligible to enter kindergarten.

Immunization requirements are: 3 doses of DTaP, DTP, DT, or Td vaccine, one given on or after the 4th birthday; 3 doses of Polio vaccine; 2 doses of MMR or MMRV vaccine, given on or after 12 months of age and separated by at least one month; 3 doses of pediatric Hepatitis B vaccine; and 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) or MMRV given on or after 12 months of age or written documentation (including year) of varicella disease from parent, guardian, or health care provider will be accepted. If the child has had varicella disease, they do not need any varicella shots. Also, students entering school for the first time, including kindergarteners, will be required to provide proof of a vision evaluation taken within six months prior to the student's entrance. Kindergarten physical examinations may be made within six months of the time of entry into kindergarten. Appointments can be made with your child's physician after March 1, 2021. Physical examination forms are available in the Brainard nurse's office.

Please call the school office (402)545-2081 by Friday, March 26, 2021 for an application to be mailed to you. Please bring your incoming Pre-School student along with your child's certified birth certificate, immunization record, and completed application.

Pre-School spots will be filled according to these applications. We will still accept applications after March 26, 2021. Students who are already in the program and are age eligible will retain a spot for the following year. Applicants will fill open spots based on age, oldest children (age 4) being accepted first and then the younger ones (age 3) if there is room. We will not be asking parents for their preference of morning/afternoon preschool.

Children age 3 or 4 on or before July 31st are eligible for Pre-School. If your child will be 5 before July 31st please see the Kindergarten registration requirements. Pre-School will be Monday-Thursday. There will be a morning and afternoon session: Morning Session: 8:00 A.M.- 11:30 A.M. (Students can ride the morning bus route to school/will need to be picked up by parent); Afternoon Session: 12:00 P.M. – 3:30 P.M. (Students will need to be dropped off by parent/can ride afternoon bus route home). Pre-School Fee: \$60 per month/district students and \$70 per month/students out of the district, due on the first day of each month (this cost will include a snack each day and other incidentals that may occur).

BOYS AND GIRLS STATE WILL BE JUNE 13-19. Boys State will be held on the campus of the University of Nebraska at Lincoln. Girls state will be held virtually. Boys & Girls in the Junior class are eligible to apply. This year Boys & Girls State does not conflict with the ACT or Close Up. Please see Mr. Cidlik for an application.

HOW TO WEAR A MASK

While you are in quarantine or in isolation, wearing a cloth face mask at home could stop coronavirus from spreading to the people you live with. Not everyone who has been close to someone with COVID-19 will catch it.

WEAR IT AT HOME

If you live with other people.

DURING ISOLATION OR QUARANTINE



YOUR MASK SHOULD

- Fit snugly but comfortably.
- Stay in place over your nose and mouth with ties or loops.
- Have at least 2 layers of cloth.
- Allow you to breathe.
- Be able to be washed and machine dried without damage or change to shape.

WEAR IT ALL THE TIME

Wear your mask at all times when you are in isolation or quarantine.

Tell the people who live with you that they should wear a mask at all times too.

FACE MASKS SHOULD NOT BE WORN BY CHILDREN UNDER TWO YEARS OLD

COVER YOUR MOUTH & NOSE

Make sure your mask fits right and covers both your mouth and nose.

WASH YOUR MASK DAILY

Put the mask in the dirty laundry as soon as you take it off.

Use hot water between each daily use. You can use your washing machine.

WASH YOUR HANDS

Before you put the mask on and right after you take your mask off.

DON'T TOUCH YOUR FACE

Avoid touching the mask and your face while you are wearing a mask.

COVID-19 is spreading in Nebraska

Here's what you can do to stay safe and stop the spread:

Avoid the Three Cs

1. Crowded Places



Avoid gathering in groups where you can't maintain 6-feet distance from others.

2. Close Contact



Wear a mask or **maintain** 6-feet distance when you're with people you don't live with.

3. Confined Spaces



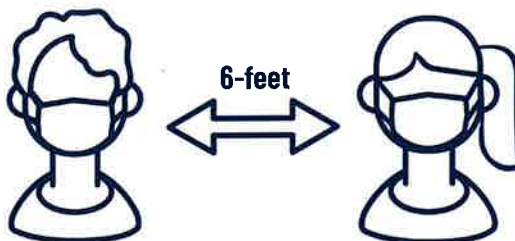
Avoid enclosed spaces with poor ventilation.

WHEN YOU SPEND MORE THAN 15 MINUTES WITH OTHER PEOPLE ...



Avoid crowded places and limit time in enclosed spaces.



Wear a mask over your nose and mouth or **maintain** 6-feet distance from people you don't live with.



Wash your hands often.
