The Foundation's goal is to be self-sufficient through the alumni. Types of gifts accepted are

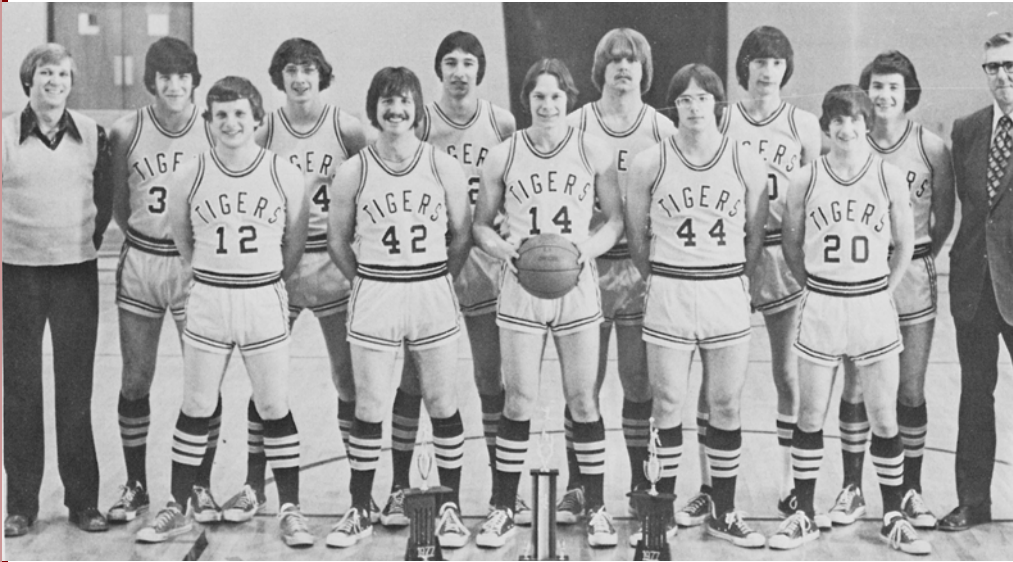
memorials, cash, securities, life insurance, and bequests.

### Alumni Spotlight: Wendy (Makovicka) Leu

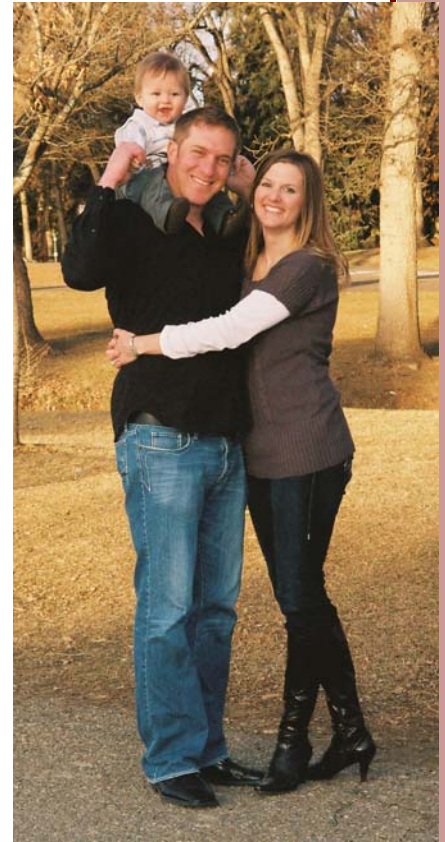
